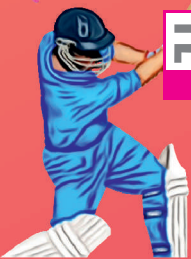

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CULTURAL EVENTS

PHOTOGRAPHY

- The Photographs can be taken with any Camera, i.e DSLR, Digital Camera or Phone Cameras.
- The photos should be taken on the first day i.e. 2nd December. Best Photos will be selected on the basis of their Composition and subject.
- Photographs should be minimum 1MB in Size. Preferably resolution, as taken.
- Photo enhancements is allowed such as sharpening, contrast adjustment, or simple cropping will be allowed but you are not allowed to manipulate the content
- All submitted images are non-returnable. The file name for each image should be clearly labeled with the participant's name, caption of the photo.

CREATIVE WIRE BENDING

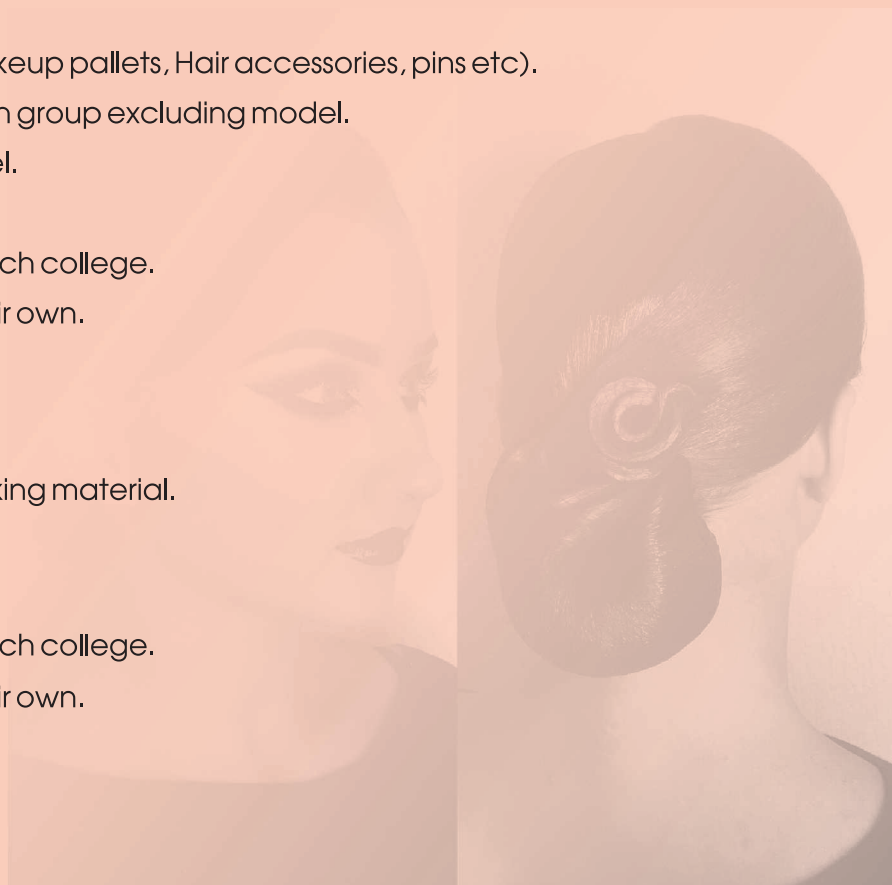
- Participants should get their own wires and material. The wires will be of stainless steel 0.5mm and 0.7mm in diameter and 1m in length. Participants can cut and attach the wires themselves.
- No additional dental wax can be used to add or customise your wire. No accessories nor props (gears etc.) are allowed.
- Participants are allowed to bend the given orthodontic wire in any shape, design or style based on the theme.
- No instruments will be provided. Participants must bring their own instruments for bending or cutting the wire.
- A time frame of 1.5 hours will be given for the competition.

MAKEUP AND HAIR DO

- Participants should bring their own material (makeup pallets, Hair accessories, pins etc).
- Maximum 2 Participants will be permitted in each group excluding model.
- Participants have to come along with one model.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own.

DIY JEWELLERY MAKING

- Participants should bring their own jewellery making material.
- This is a solo event.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own.



STONE ART

- Participants should bring their own stones of interest and base for their painting.
- This is a solo event.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Decision will be taken on the basis of creativity and efforts of the participants.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own.

SAPLING POT DECORATION

- Sapling WILL BE provided to the participants.
- Participants will have to bring their own decoration and paint material
- This is a solo event.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own.
- Judges will make decision on the basis of creativity and design

SINGING (SOLO/GROUP)

Common Rules:

- Karaoke is allowed.
- Participants must bring their own karaoke.
- Live instruments can also be played.
- CD to be handed over to the sound desk 60 minutes before the performance.
- Judges decision will be final.
- Judgment will be based on the quality of singing only & not on make-up, costume or action of the team.

SOLO:

- Time Limit : 3-5 minutes
- Language : Hindi/Western

GROUP:

- Time Limit : 5 minutes
- Team should have at least 3 members & maximum 8 members.

DANCE (SOLO/GROUP)

- Duration for dance on stage must be within 5-7 mins.
- Obscenity, vulgarity and wardrobe malfunction of any sort will lead to automatic disqualification.
- Each group must contain 8-12 members. No substitution permitted.
- No explicit gestures, comments and movements
- All music must be submitted 30 mins prior to start of competition.
- Music in mp3 format should be submitted one day prior to the event. Each performance music file must contain its own track and be labeled.
- Team/ participant should have a Backup of music throughout the event.
- All participants will perform in the order they are scheduled.
- Performer must be a registered candidate.
- It is compulsory for all participants to carry their college ID Cards.
- Dancers must be ready to perform 30mins prior to scheduled time.
- Any personal belongings, costumes or dance apparel left behind at the competition will not be our responsibility.
- A team which fails to perform during its allotted slot will not be given second chance.
- Use of props allowed.

FASHION SHOW COMPETITION

- Time allotted: 8+2 minutes
- No of participants: 18+2 with MC
- Anything that promotes obscenity and explicitly is banned
- Exceeding time limit will result to negative marking of the group.
- Participants should confirm registration 30 minutes prior to event.
- Participants should bring their respective college id cards.
- Every college is advised to bring own props
- Music in mp3 format should be submitted one day prior to the event. Team/ participant should have a Backup throughout the event.
- Props such as cigars, wine bottles etc are prohibited.
- All props, etc. used by the colleges must be cleared immediately from the stage after the performance and from the college premises by the end of the day.
- Obscenity, vulgarity and wardrobe malfunction of any sort will lead to automatic disqualification.
- Do not use fire, flammable substance as props.
- A team which fails to perform during its allotted slot will not be given second chances.



TALENT HUNT

- Contestants registered for the conference are eligible for participation
- Each contestant will be allotted 3 min for the performance
- Each contestant will be allowed no more than 5 min on stage. marks will be deducted in case contestant runs over five minutes on stage
- Two judge will judge the event
- Candidates and contestants who fail to perform in the allotted time will not be given a Second chance
- Contestant should arrange for props in case they require
- USE of fire or any inflammable object as props is not Allowed
- If any music needs to be played, a prior intimation of the same should be made to the cultural committee, a recording of the music should be brought in pen drive.
- Obscenity & Vulgarity of any Sort will lead to Automatic Disqualification

T SHIRT PAINTING

- Participants should bring their own material T Shirt paints and other needed material .
- This is a solo event.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own.

RANGOLI

- Participants should bring their own material to make Rangoli .
- Maximum 4 Participants will be permitted in each group.
- Maximum Area given to make Rangoli in 5x5 Feet maximum , it can be less also.
- Time given is 1.5 hour.
- Any number of entries can be entertained by each college.
- Theme to be selected by the participants on their own

NAIL ART

- Make a team of maximum 2 members (one who will paint and other on whom art will be performed).
- Teams should get their own material.
- Each team will be given a time of 120 minutes.
- Decision of the jury is final

MEME MAKING

- This is a solo event. A participant can submit only one meme.
- The theme is 'online classes'
- Meme photo should be in .Jpeg or .jpg and file size should not exceed 5 MB
- Plagiarism is Not allowed
- The meme must promote Healthy humor. Offensive meme will not be entertained.
- Participant can submit their meme on 2nd December 2022 (10 am to 12 pm)

FACE PAINTING

- It is a team event. There can be only 2 participants in a team.
- Participants should bring their own colors, brushes etc.
- Time limit is 60 minutes.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of creativity, innovation and design.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

RULES & REGULATION FOR SPORTS

CHESS

- Chess will be played according to the universally accepted rule. However, there will be a time limit of 25 minutes per game. Post 25 minute winner will be decided depending among status of the game.
- There will be a point system depending on the time taken to finish the game and the winner will be awarded point accordingly to progress in next round or to get bonus point.
- The draw for the same will be followed and participant unable to report on time will be relegated and the opponent will be progress to next round immediately.
- Venue – Dental library

CRICKET (Boys & Girls) with Tennis Ball

- Each team is made up of 14 players with playing 11.
- The bowler must bowl 6 legal deliveries to constitute an over.
- A game must have two umpires stood at either end of the wicket.
- A batsmen can be given out by either being bowled (the ball hitting their stumps), caught (fielder catches the ball without it bouncing), Leg Before Wicket .
- The scores are then cumulative and the team with the most runs after each innings is the winner.
- Cricket in played with 7 overs. Each team has 7 overs to bat and bowl before swapping .
- Cricket should be played according to the universally accepted rules.
- Venue – University Ground.

LAWN TENNIS

(Singles Boys & Girls), (Doubles Boys & Girls) (Mixed Double Boys & Girls)

- Lawn tennis will be played according to the universally accepted rules. However, there will be a time limit of 25 minutes per game. Post 25 minute winner will be decided depending upon status of game.
- Players cannot touch the net or posts or cross opponent side.
- If the ball hits or touches the players that's counts as penalty.
- Players must bring their own rackets
- Venue- University sports ground (lawn tennis court).

PAPER PRESENTATION

CARROM

- Players get the three chances in their first turn to break. In those particular chances, it does not matter whether the striker hit the carrom men or not. However, when a player pockets the chosen color carrom or queen, then he is provided with second chance. But if he /she commits a foul or is not able to pocket any pieces, then the chance of strike will be passed to another end.
- A player needs to pocket the queen first and then on the very first chance, he/she also needs to pocket the other carrom men of his chosen color. If he/she fails to do that then queen will be returned to the board.
- Again of carrom has a maximum of 29 points. If the player has less than 24 points at the end of the game and also got the queen then he/she will be rewarded with 5 bonus points. But if he /she scores 24 or more points then the queen will not bring the reward for the player.
- Venue : University Ground

VOLLEYBALL (Boys & Girls)

- Volleyball should be played according to the universally accepted rules.
- Each team should have total 9 players with playing 6.
- Total 3 sets of 10 points will be played during qualifier round and 3 sets of 20 points will be played in semi-final and final matches.
- Rotations of players is not mandatory.
- Total Boys teams in tournament is 6 which are divided into 2 groups (group A and B) and 2 teams from each group will be qualified for semi-finals.
- Total Girls teams in the tournament is 2 which will be played with each other in final match.
- The matches will be played according to the schedule time.
- Venue –University sports ground (volleyball court).

BASKETBALL (Boys & Girls)

- The ball may be batted in any direction with one or both hands (never with fist).
- A player cannot run with the ball, the player must throw it from the spot on which he catches it, allowance to be made for a man who catches the ball when running at a good speed
- No shouldering, holding, pushing, tripping or striking in any way the person of an opponent shall be allowed. The first infringement of this rule by any person shall count as a foul; the second shall disqualify him until the next goal is made or, if there was evident intent to injure the person, for the whole of the game. No substitute allowed.
- A goal shall be made when the ball is thrown or batted from the grounds into the basket and stays there (without falling), providing those defending the goal do not touch or disturb the goal. If the ball rests on the edge, and the opponent moves the basket, it shall count as a goal.
- Venue-University sports ground (basketball court).

BADMINTON

Singles (Boys & Girls), Doubles (Boys & Girls), Mixed Doubles

- Serves may land opposite quadrant on the opponent's side of the court in singles play. Lines are for doubles play, during which the serve must land in the opposite quadrant of service.
- Points are awarded when:

The server serves to land the shuttlecock into a playable territory (i.e., the opponent's court).

Either player fails to make a successful return.

- Players switch sides after each set.
- Players must bring their own rackets
- Venue: D-Block.

TABLE TENNIS

Singles (Boys & Girls), Doubles (Boys & Girls), Mixed Doubles

- Serves may land anywhere on the opponent's side of the table in singles play. Lines are for doubles play, during which the ball must land in the opposite quadrant of service.
- If a ball touches the net and lands in the opponent's court, a "let" is called, and the serve is repeated.
- Points are awarded when:

The server serves to land the ping pong ball into a playable territory (i.e., the opponent's court).

Either player fails to make a successful return.

If the ball is hit before it bounces on your side.

- Players switch sides after each game.
- Players must bring their own rackets

FOOTBALL (Boys & Girls)

- Football will be played according to the university accepted rules. However there will be a time limit of 30 minutes per game which includes 15 minutes of each half. There will be gap of 5 minutes between 2 halves.
- Each teams comprised of total 9 players -7 playing and 2 extras.
- Total there are 4 boys football teams playing in the tournament. So there will be two knockout games involving 4 teams and winner of both matches will play in the final for the trophy.

Venue—University sports ground
